

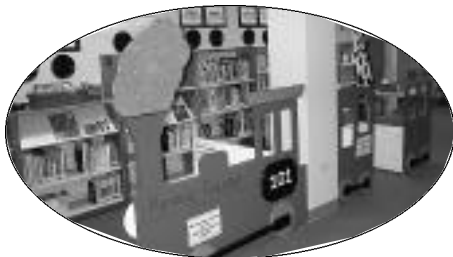
faith harder memorial **LIBRARY**

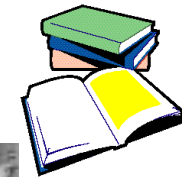

They wanted to continue her reading legacy and proposed a library at her favorite place, St. Luke's. Faith's family began collecting books and videos and, using a portable bookshelf, opened the library in the Summer of 1998.

Vern Harder, Faith's husband, took the main responsibility of picking up the books, putting the cards and pockets in each of the books and returning them to church. Other family members catalogued and labeled them.

The library is a fond memory of Faith Harder, but her family hopes even more that it is an encouragement to the children of St. Luke's to grow and learn so that they can achieve the great potential that God has placed inside of each one of them.

How do I check out a book or video?

1. Select book and/or video.



2. Locate the card in the inside front cover of book or on the back of the video.



3. Clearly print your first and last name and the date due. Books and videos are due back in 2 weeks.



4. Place the card in the box marked Check Out Cards.



5. Take a date due form from the basket and write the due date in the space provided. Place this slip in the pocket to remind you when to return it to the library.
