Palm Sunday & Holy Week

Not everyone welcomed Jesus. Some of the Church leaders thought the crowd was too loud. They questioned who Jesus was. Jesus would later realize the time for Him to leave this world had come. He invited his friends the Disciples for His last Passover meal. Jesus loved His friends and wanted to show them His love for them and how they would remember Him. Holy Week has begun.



Scripture: Matthew 21:9

The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

The **PALM BRANCH** represents Palm Sunday. We remember the day when Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey as the King of Peace. The people were so excited that King Jesus was coming to the city. They didn't have flags but they cut down palm branches and waved them in the air. They shouted out "Hosanna in the highest" as Jesus rode into the city. It was so exciting.
