UNIT 1: JOY • LESSON 3:

"Jesus Brings Joy"

LUKE 2:1-7



ADVENT:

The season of Advent is the 4 weeks before Christmas (Nov. 29-Dec. 24.) Each Sunday we prepare our hearts for the birth of Jesus and focus on a special word and light candles in our Advent wreath. Today we light the candles of HOPE, JOY & PEACE. We explored joy last week (and it is our word for this 4-week unit), this week our word is **PEACE**. Peace is a feeling of calm and contentment and that all is right with the world.

BIBLE STORY:

In today's Bible story, we learn of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem and celebrate the birth of Jesus.



The man in power,

the emperor Caesar Augustus, wanted everyone to go to their hometowns to be counted. Joseph was from Bethlehem, so he and Mary had to go to Bethlehem. It was a hard trip, walking from Nazareth all the way to Bethlehem, and Mary was going to have her baby very soon! Bethlehem was very crowded and busy when they arrived. That night, baby Jesus was born. Mary wrapped him in cloth and laid him in a manger because there was no room for them in the guestroom.

The people in Bethlehem weren't able to do much for Mary and Joseph but they did offer them a place to stay in the stable and I'm sure they helped Mary with the birth and helped them in the days after Jesus was born. What can you do to help someone this week?

How do you think Mary and Joseph felt when Jesus was born?


Jesus Brings Joy Road to Bethlehem




Instructions
