UNIT 1: JOY · LESSON 2: "Joseph's Joy" MATTHEW 1:18-24



ADVENT:

The season of Advent is the 4 weeks before Christmas (Nov. 29-Dec. 24.) Each Sunday we prepare our hearts for the birth of Jesus and focus on a special word and light candles in our Advent wreath. Today we light the candles of HOPE & JOY. We explored hope last week, this week our word is **JOY**. Joy is a feeling of gratitude and happiness that fills you with delight.

BIBLE STORY:

In today's Bible story, we find Joseph in a tough position. His soon-to-be wife is pregnant. Now Joseph must make a decision to marry her or call off the engagement:



There was a man named Joseph whose family lived in Bethlehem. Joseph came from the family of King David. Joseph was engaged to marry a woman named Mary. Joseph learned that Mary was going to have a Baby. Joseph had a dream. In the dream, he saw an angel of God. The angel said, "Joseph, the baby that Mary is having is God's gift to the whole world. Marry her and name the baby, Jesus." When he woke up, Joseph married Mary. When Mary gave birth to a son, Joseph named the baby Jesus. He was grateful to God for his new family and that he was chosen to be Jesus' father.

Even though we might be going through a difficult time or situation, the Advent season invites us to slow down, accept, and see there is joy coming. Look for the joy around you that God already has provided. With all my heart I glorify the Lord! In the depths of who I am I rejoice in God my savior. Luke 1:46-47
