"BIBLE 101: Overview"

Welcome to Sunday School and our BIBLE 101: Overview of THE BIBLE lesson. Wow, where do we begin.?

WHAT IS THE BIBLE?:

The Bible is a book that is made up of collection of books **(66 total!)** compiled over thousands of years by over 40 different writers or authors, covering 4000 years of human history.

The Bible contains **39 books in the Old Testament** - these were stories written before lesus was born and put together around 250 BC.

The Bible also contains 27 books in the New

Testament and these are stories about Jesus and his life and teachings and were written shortly after Jesus died from 50-70 AD and were put all together and included with the Old Testament around 150 AD.

Wow! That's a lot of books and a lot of time...

The Bible tells the story of ancient people and how they experienced God in their lives. It weaves the history of the time and different struggles and victories that these people encountered and how God was the one constant in all of their stories and brought them hope and purpose. It tells of how Jesus came to teach people about God's love and how the Christian church began. The Bible offers treasured words that help us learn ways that God wants us to live. The Bible is so important because it is our story and guidebook as Christians.

The Bible started as "oral tradition" which means it was first told as stories to one another before there were ways to write it down and then print it. Once we were able to print, in 1456, the Bible became the very first complete book to ever be printed.

The Bible contains lots of different types of books (law, history, poetry, letters, etc..) and different styles of writing and is the most translated book of all time. It was taken from it's original language of Hebrew and Greek and translated into different style and languages so
