




ELEMENTARY SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON - MAY 9, 2021

UNIT 3: LOVE • SESSION 10: "Peter and Tabitha" ACTS 9:36-43



SHARING LOVE: This week's story is about a special disciple named Tabitha. Her Greek name is Dorcas. She was known for her good works and compassion. She helped those in need in her community of Joppa and made clothing for them. Sadly, Tabitha fell ill and died. Peter was called to come to her home quickly. Everyone loved Tabitha and was so very sad. Peter performed a miracle and brought Tabitha back to life. This is not easily explained but miracles show us the power of God and that's what the people felt. It helped the community to understand that they were to love one another just like Tabitha had loved them. **It inspired the**



people to share God's love.

BIBLE STORY: Acts 4:32-37

There was a disciple named Tabitha. She loved and cared for everyone who was in need. She made tunics and clothing to give away to people. Tabitha became very sick, and she died. Her friends washed her body and laid her body on a bed.

Her friends were very sad. They heard that Peter was nearby, so they sent two people to find him. The two people found Peter and begged him to come back to Tabitha's house. Peter went with them. Peter entered Tabitha's room. All of Tabitha's friends were there crying. Peter asked everyone to leave Tabitha's room. He knelt down and prayed. Then Peter said, "Tabitha get up!" Tabitha opened her eyes and sat up. Peter helped her stand as they called all of Tabitha's friends back into the room. She was alive!

Take time this week to think about who you rely on in hard times. Who shows you God's love? Tabitha's friends all prayed for her and Peter prayed for her. Praying for one another is an important part of our faith and one way that we can share God's love. Love each other like the members of your family.

Romans 12:10a


