BIBLE STORY:

There are 2 creation stories in the Bible - in Genesis - this is the first one and very poetic and beautiful. It reminds us of God's great love for the world. This portion of the story shows God's love of humanity and reminds us that God is a part of all of us. Each of us is a **REFLECTION** of God.




On the sixth day, God created humans. Male and female made in God's image to care for the earth and all of the creatures in

it. God told the people that all of the plants and trees yielding seeds and fruit and the grasses were there to provide food for the people and the animals. God saw that everything was good and on the seventh day God rested. God blessed this day and made it holy.

On the seventh day God rests, but this does not mean God will not continue to act and interact with creation. To rest actually puts things back into motion and calls for humans to help carry out God's creative process. We are then reminded that all is right, good and holy and God honors all of creation with God's blessing.

When God creates humans, God does so in God's own image. To be created in the image of God is as if we are mirrors of God in the world. Each human on earth is unique and yet on the inside we are all connected. Everyone has God within, no matter what we look like on the outside, and it is because of this that we are able to see each other as children of God. We are all important in God's eyes and God loves us and wants us to love and respect and care for each other.


