Counting Our Blessings

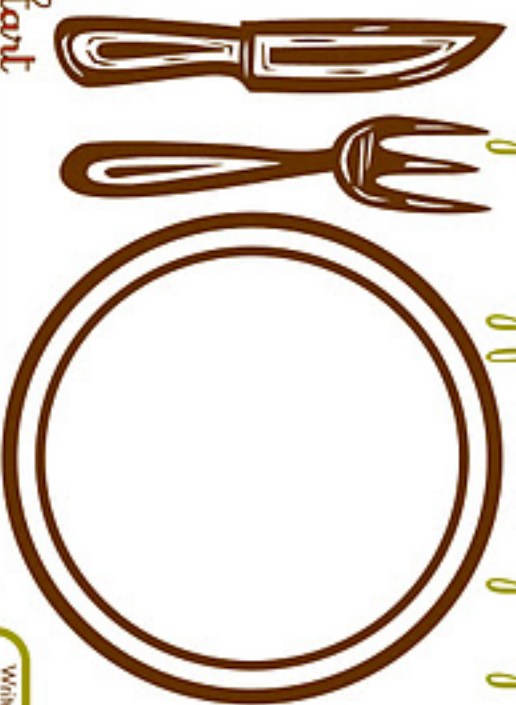

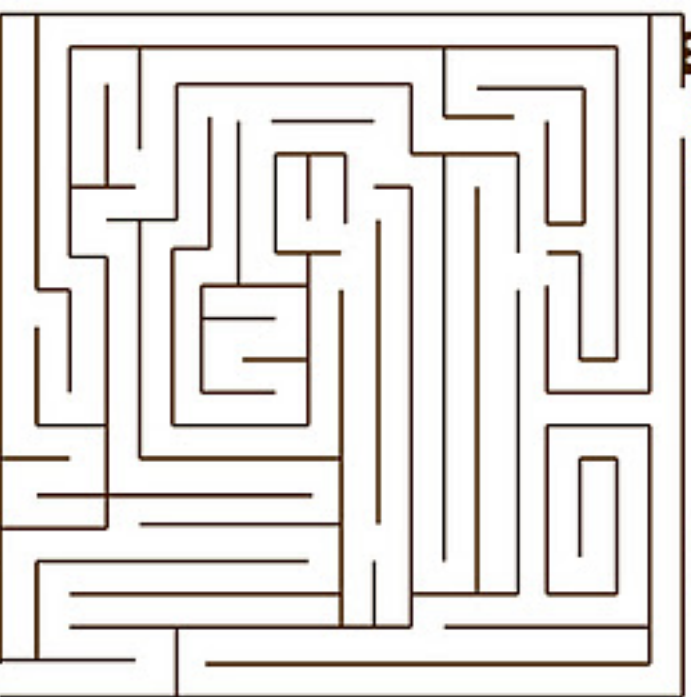
