Pentecost: Happy Birthday to the Church!

Final Fruits of the Spirit:

Kindness is being friendly, generous and considerate to others always.

Goodness means God can depend on us to turn away from bad things. We need to choose to act with kindness and goodness through our actions so others can see these fruits in us.

Faithfulness is being true, devoted and loyal. Doing what you say and being true to your word. God and Jesus are faithful to us.

Gentleness is being soft, careful and mild mannered to others. I think of holding the baby bunnies at Easter and perhaps a new baby. Taking the time to always be gentle with our words and our actions.

Self-control is having the ability to control what we say and do at all times. To be able to live the way God wants us to we have to have control of what we do and say. If you are feeling out of control remember to step back and take a deep breath. Think about your choices and choose the best choice by managing your emotions and impulses and choosing a positive response.

Kindness (apple)Goodness (banana)Faithfulness (pear)Gentleness (cherries)Self-control (peach)




The Holy Spirit had come, just as Jesus promised!
